



Ways to Help Bellevue Community Food Bank - Adults

Donate fresh foods (fruits, vegetables, meats- call in advance to set up donation time for proper handling of fresh items) ph 615-212-9199

Organize a food drive at your employment, club, church, neighborhood - ask for our cheat sheet "How to Organize a Food Drive"

Donate cash, or organize a cash donation at your employment, club, church - many employers will "match" donations

Volunteer at large food drives - notices are sent in advance asking for volunteers on facebook page, church bulletins - See and like Bellevue Community Food Bank page on Facebook or check Bellevue United Methodist Church website or facebook page

Volunteer at the Food Bank - determine your availability before commitment, talk with coordinator at Food Bank about opportunities (work at actual Food Bank involves physical strength, good reading and organizational skills, and will involve carrying food boxes)

Volunteer to pick up donations for Food Bank (pick up donations from grocery stores, or other donors - usually on a weekly basis) - requires physical strength
